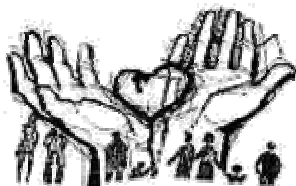
House-of-God Keeping UNITED IN THE SAME MIND, IN THE SAME PURPOSE
