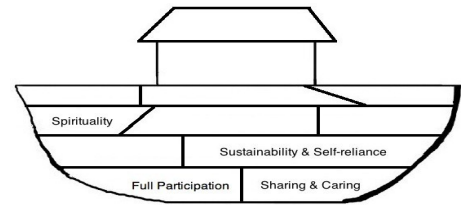


Cornerstone:
